

Schedule A - By-Law and Constitution Breach Fine Schedule

The Association's affiliated Clubs have agreed a list of financial fines to be applied for specific breaches by a member Club of the Association Constitution rules and/ or By-Laws. The offending Club will be invoiced for any breach referring to the relevant clause applicable.

Note apart from the financial fines applicable there may also be other penalties that may apply eg. Suspensions, loss of points, relegation, etc

	Match Cautions – penalty to the Club for playing any player whilst suspended	\$200.00

If in doubt - write the player numbers for all ages - particularly Under 11 and over.

If you have players playing up - write down the age/ grade group they are currently registered in

Do not alter the match sheet after the referee signs off.

Place the match sheet in the canteen letterbox straight after the game...the same day. Enter the score online.
Contact the President ASAP if there is a delay.

Use the computer generated matchsheets to avoid unsatisfactory sheets.

RTOs and spectators of clubs can incur penalties as well as the club. Reports are sent in regularly to SGFA which are enforced with penalties. Remember this is club football - there are kids and families around.
